Attention 5th Grade Parents! It's time to start planning for the next immunizations needed by your student. **Prior to the start of 6th Grade all students are required to get meningococcal and Tdap vaccines, as well as to receive TWO Hepatitis A vaccines.** It's a good idea to call your child's doctor and get an appointment scheduled to get these mandatory shots. They are very important to your child's health and well-being! Thank you for your help in getting appointments set up for your student.

Reminder for parents: Students are not allowed to transport any medications. This includes inhalers. Parents are required to complete a Medication Permission Form for any medications that students must take at school. Parents or adult designees are responsible for the safe transportation of all medications. Thank you for your help in following this extremely important policy to keep your student and all other students safe!

The testing will take place on February 21st, 2018 from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m. for students in grades 1 and 4 and February 22nd from 3:00 – 6:00 p.m. for students in grades 3 and 5. Testing will take place at the Lawrence Education and Community Center (LECC) located at 6501 Sunnyside Road.
